Are class sizes really lower this year?

Yes! Early reports show our enrollment (nearly 12,000 districtwide) is on track to meet projections this year, and with fewer schools, the buildings are full. The good news is classrooms are less full than last year, thanks to community members who approved the operating levy referendum in November 2008.

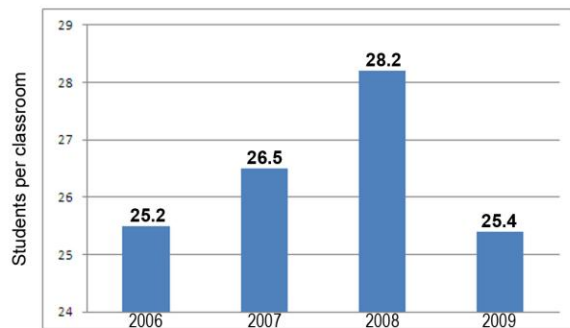
The chart at right shows average districtwide class sizes for grade 5 and for core classes at high school over the last four years. The figure listed for 2009 was the target class size used in referendum information. At every grade level, we're very close to the districtwide average class size targets cited during the referendum.

Remember, average class sizes means that some classes will be larger and some smaller than the average number.

Enrollment fluctuates too much during the month of September to provide an accurate enrollment report. A full report on enrollment will be presented to the school board October 19, including charts showing average class sizes for every school in the district.
